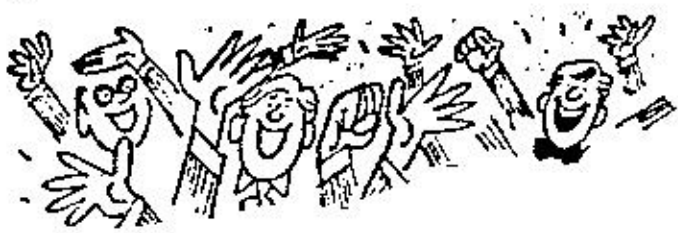
NEW ROSTERS AVAILABLE
