## Singles Strategy

Subject: When To Move Up To the Net

When at your base line, concentrate on moving your opponent around so as to force a short return. When you're able to move in on a short ball, stroke a deep approach shot, preferably to the backhand side, then continue to move up to the net for the "candy" volley.
