

### TENNIS TIPS By Percy Hughes

Learn to make your "other hand work for you. Your non-racquet hand can be used to adjust the angle of your racquet face. This hand should be holding the racquet at its throat. At this position it can help you change grips and also save some wear and tear on your racquet hand between rallies.

For the beginning server:

- 1. The starting position is ball toss shoulder to the net.
- Placement of the ball should be to the right of the leading foot and about 12 inches in front of the leading foot. (For right handed servers.)
- Racquet is in "back scratch" position. Bit up and forward.
- Follow through on the left side of the body.

These tips might not work for a McEnroe, but for a beginner it is a good way to start.
