## TENNIS TIPS

### When Receiving a Serve

If the serve is obviously out, do not return it; however, you or your opponent should be sure it doesn't roll behind you where you could step on it during play.

### Never Assume a Point Is Over

Play all balls until they bounce twice on the court or until they bounce outside the court. It's easy to admire your good shot and not expect it to come back, but sometimes your opponent runs it down and returns it. Many times you think your partner has put the shot away, but it is returned. Remember, play every point until it's over.
