

TENNIS TIPS

Use A Mirror To Check Your Strokes

Before a match use your mirror to check all your strokes. Practice them in slow motion, stopping your racquet at different points to check its alignment and your body position. Check your whole stroke—follow-through and your weight transfer. Don't stop until you like what you see. Make that full swing nice and smooth.

Proper Serving Stance

Make believe you're a marksman taking aim at your target. Align your feet and upper body sideways to your intended target for a good starting position. You will be able to transfer your body weight forward and rotate your upper body more easily into the serve. This way you'll have greater power and accuracy.



Above all, Lord, this pleasure is a thing I'd like to share, So when you grant my wish, be sure that all my friends are there.




