

DIRECTIONS TO DECATHLON

Decathlon Athletic Club is in Bloomington on the south frontage road located immediately south of Interstate 494.

Traveling west on 494, get off at the 12th St & Portland ramp. Cross the freeway at 12th St (first light), turning left at the end of the bridge and continuing to Decathlon. Traveling east on 494, get off at the Portland & 12th St ramp which leads directly into the south frontage road. Continue across 12th to Decathlon.



TENNIS TIPS by Ernie Greene (USPTA and USPTR)

PROBLEM

One of the most common mechanical problems some players have is hitting the forehand and backhand groundstrokes from a position above the ball. (The Drive)

SOLUTION

If you are having the problem, you must become more aware of where your racquet face is during every portion of your strokes. The forehand and backhand should be practiced slowly, in front of a mirror, and you should freeze (stop) the stroke at various stages to see exactly where you are swinging the racquet face.

Once you know where your racquet face is on your groundstrokes, concentrate on dropping it (racquet face) below the level of the contact point as you start your forward swing. Even with a so-called loop forehand, dropping the racquet face should be part of the backswing, not the forward swing.

It also helps to flex your knees during the stroke, helping to lift the swing up and over the ball by straightening the knees slightly as you complete the stroke.
